

**URBAN GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND
(EA - RATE CODE 7X7)**

Availability:

To all customers who do not qualify as residential in the City of Auburn, Nebraska, where the maximum demand recorded by the Board of Public Works metering exceeds 100 KW but does not exceed 500 KW for two consecutive months. In the event the demand is less than or equal to 100 KW for 48 months, the Urban General Service rate schedule will apply if requested by the customer.

Any customer in the City of Auburn, Nebraska, may request this rate and it shall become available after necessary metering equipment is installed; however, it shall remain in effect for twelve months before another rate may be chosen by the customer.

Type of Service:

Single-phase or three-phase, 60 Hertz service at standard Board of Public Works voltages, maximum single-phase capacity 167 KVA, with a maximum motor size of 10 horsepower connected single-phase 208 or 240 Volt or 3 horsepower connected single-phase 120 Volt, and a maximum three-phase motor size of 200 horsepower (except special cases).

Demand:

The maximum monthly integrated 15 minutes kilowatt load occurring at any time during the Billing Period and measured with a Board of Public Works meter or determined by other means.

Monthly Rate:

Administrative Charge of \$30.00 plus

Demand Charge of:

Summer

\$6.30 per KW of Billing Demand

Winter

\$4.51 per KW of Billing Demand

Energy Charge of:

Summer

\$0.0453 per kwh for all usage

Winter

\$0.0404 per kwh for all usage

Primary Service Discount:

Where the customer takes service from the Board of Public Works standard primary distribution voltage and the customer owns all transformation and electric system from the primary distribution voltage to the secondary utilization voltage level, the following discounts apply:

- ◆ Three percent (3%) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the metering point and delivery point are located at the same point on the Board of Public Works primary voltage distribution line.
- ◆ One and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the delivery point is located on the Board of Public Works primary voltage distribution line and the metering point is located on the low voltage side of the customer's transformation.

Where the metering point is on the primary voltage side of the Board of Public Works transformers, the following discount will apply:

- ◆ One and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment.

Power Factor Discount:

- ◆ Two percent (2%) of the total monthly bill, after any other discounts, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the power factor is measured by the Board of Public Works, and Board of Public Works has determined the power factor will always be between 0.90 lagging and 0.90 leading.

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$30.00 before discounts.

Monthly Bill:

The monthly bill computed in accordance with the Monthly Rate is due upon receipt. Bills not paid by the delinquent date indicated on the utility bill shall have a penalty amount added to the net monthly bill (excluding sales tax). In case that date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Board of Public Works holiday, the next working day shall be considered the same as the delinquent date.

**RURAL GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND
(EB, EJ, EN, ER - RATE CODE 7X7)**

Availability:

To all customers who do not qualify as residential in the Villages of Brownville, Johnson, and Nemaha, Nebraska and rural areas where the maximum demand recorded by the Board of Public Works metering exceeds 100 KW but does not exceed 500 KW for two consecutive months. In the event the demand is less than or equal to 100 KW for 48 months, the Rural General Service rate schedule will apply if requested by the customer.

Any customer may request this rate and it shall become available after necessary metering equipment is installed; however, it shall remain in effect for twelve months before another rate may be chosen by the customer.

Type of Service:

Single-phase or three-phase (where available), 60 Hertz service at standard Board of Public Works voltages, maximum single-phase capacity 100 KVA, with a maximum motor size of 10 horsepower connected single-phase 208 or 240 Volt (except special cases) or 3 horsepower connected single-phase 120 Volt, and a maximum three-phase motor size of 100 horsepower (except special cases).

Demand:

The maximum monthly integrated 15 minutes kilowatt load occurring at any time during the Billing Period and measured with a Board of Public Works meter or determined by other means.

Monthly Rate:

Administrative Charge of \$40.00 plus

Demand Charge of:

Primary Service Discount:

Where the customer takes service from the Board of Public Works standard primary distribution voltage and the customer owns all transformation and electric system from the primary distribution voltage to the secondary utilization voltage level, the following discounts apply:

- ◆ Three percent (3%) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the metering point and delivery point are located at the same point on the Board of Public Works primary voltage distribution line.
- ◆ One and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the delivery point is located on the Board of Public Works primary voltage distribution line and the metering point is located on the low voltage side of the customer's transformation.

Where the metering point is on the primary voltage side of the Board of Public Works transformers, the following discount will apply:

- ◆ One and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) of the monthly bill, excluding Production Cost Adjustment.

Power Factor Discount:

- ◆ Two percent (2%) of the total monthly bill, after any other discounts, excluding Production Cost Adjustment, where the power factor is measured by the Board of Public Works, and Board of Public Works has determined the power factor will always be between 0.90 lagging and 0.90 leading.

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$40.00 before discounts.

Monthly Bill:

The monthly bill computed in accordance with the Monthly Rate is due upon receipt. Bills not paid by the delinquent date indicated on the utility bill shall have a penalty amount added to the net monthly bill (excluding sales tax). In case that date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Board of Public Works holiday, the next working day shall be considered the same as the delinquent date.

Terms and Conditions:
